PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Every person at the West Adelaide Bearcats has the right to participate in sport that is safe, welcoming and inclusive. Equally, everyone plays a part in ensuring their actions and behaviours support these values.

Our club also has a responsibility to ensure participation in all club events is free of any anti-social behaviour, both on and off the court. Therefore as a player of the West Adelaide Basketball Club, I agree to participate and abide by the following code of conduct at all games, trainings and club functions.

I agree to the following:

- playing by the rules at all times;
- abiding by the Basketball SA Code of Conduct;
- abiding by the policies set out in the Club Handbook;
- respecting the rights, dignity and worth of fellow players, coaches, officials and spectators at all times, regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion;
- maintaining high standards of personal behavior at all times so as not to damage my personal reputation or the reputation of the West Adelaide Bearcats Basketball Club. This means controlling my emotions, not using bad language, having a positive attitude and showing respect to all;
- not sledging or deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent;
- not bullying or taking unfair advantages of another competitor;
- only wearing approved West Adelaide merchandise when representing the Club;
- co-operating with all coaches, team managers and committee members;
- working equally hard for myself and my team; and
- understanding that participating in the game will be at the discretion of the coach.

PARENT/GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

The West Adelaide Bearcats Basketball Club operates to provide children with the opportunity to play district basketball. We aim to provide quality coaching, with opportunities for players to develop and improve in a safe environment, where basketball can be enjoyed by all those involved.

I agree to the following:

- abiding by the Basketball SA Code of Conduct;
- abiding by the Basketball SA Zero Tolerance Policy;
- abiding by the policies set out in the Club Handbook;
- respecting the rights, dignity and worth of others involved regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion;
- not arguing with or abusing coaches and other club officials;
- applauding all good plays whether they are made by your team or the other team;
- remembering that children participate in sport for their enjoyment, not yours;
- never ridiculing or yelling at a player for making a mistake;
- showing appreciation for volunteer coaches and staff;
- ensuring your child is in full uniform at games and trainings;
- making sure your child is honest with their coaches about any injuries or sickness;
- guaranteeing that you child respects and takes care of the equipment supplied by the club;
- paying fees on or before the due date. Failure to do so will result in suspension from playing until fees are paid; and
- scoring or assisting on the scoring bench in rotation as arranged by the Team Manager.
