## Participants Instructions

Welcome to the Twilight Christmas Parade & thank you for your participation!

### PARADE NUMBER – H40

Your Parade Number reflects the assembly position you have been allocated in the Parade, however changes may occur, so please report to your allocated Section Marshal on the day.

| <b>Assembly Time</b>     | <b>5.15pm</b>  |
| <b>Assembly Location</b> | <b>Baynes Place, Port Adelaide – PARADE NUMBER H40</b>   |
| <b>Assembly Access</b>   | See Map - Arrive via Grand Junction Road (also known as Bower Rd) and enter Baynes Place via Langham Place – not via Commercial Rd   |
| <b>Parade Starts</b>     | 6pm  |
| <b>Parade finishes</b>   | Between 7pm-7.30pm, depending on you position in the Parade.<br>The Parade will finish in St. Vincent Street at <b>Todd Street</b> .<br>When your group reaches Todd Street:<br><b>Walking groups</b> must <b>turn left</b> and disembark at top of Todd Street<br><b>Vehicles</b> must continue straight along St. Vincent Street and <b>exit</b> |
| <b>Parking</b>           | Car parking is available at “Dock 1” vacant site (enter/exit via Wauwa Street), the Port Canal and Port Mall Shopping Centres, and TAFE complex (Nile Street).<br>Please note once the parade starts cars will not be able to enter and exit until after the event has finished at 9pm   |
| <b>Shuttle Bus</b>       | A Shuttle Bus will be available <i>before the event</i> to shuttle participants between the Port Dock Brewery Hotel (Todd Street near Dock 1 car park) and the Baynes Place assembly area. The shuttle bus will operate between 4pm and 5.30pm.  |
| <b>After Party</b>       | A free After Party will be held in Commercial Road near the lighthouse. This section of Commercial Road will be closed until 11pm.   |
| <b>Presentation</b>      | We encourage your group to make your Parade entry as <b>festive</b> as possible, with Christmas decorations and plenty of colour.  |
| <b>Road Closures</b>     | Please pay particular attention to road closures (detailed on page 3) and ensure all family and friends are well aware of the road traffic restrictions. We recommend spectators arrive at the event early to avoid road closures and to secure a good viewing position.   |

## Participants Directions – please read carefully

1. Arrive at Baynes Place (entrance via Grand Junction Road & Langham Place) at about 5.15pm for assembly.
2. Access to Baynes Place is NOT permitted via Commercial Road.
3. Participants should park at the Dock 1 (entry/exit via Wauwa Street), Port Canal Shopping Centre or Port Mall Shopping Centre.
4. Look for the Section Sign that relates to your **Parade Number – H40**
5. If in doubt, ask a Marshal – quote your Parade Number.
6. Marshals will be wearing reflective yellow 'Event Staff' vests.
7. A Marshal will direct you to your assembly position.
8. Wait in your assembly position until directed by a Marshal to move into the Parade
9. During the Parade follow instructions from Marshals.
10. Parade concludes at the corner of Todd Street and St Vincent Street.
11. All participants must complete the route to the end before leaving the Parade.
12. Walking groups must turn left into Todd Street and continue to Dock 1 area at the top of Todd Street (do not stop walking until instructed by a marshal).
13. Vehicles must continue along St. Vincent Street – no stopping before Wauwa Street.
14. **DO NOT stop** until directed by a marshal, as this can lead to major congestion and the Parade stopping. Simply follow the directions from marshals.
15. Wait to be directed by Marshals for disassembly.

**The Parade relies on your co-operation to ensure its smooth running.**

## Conditions of Entry:

1. The Parade is a fun event and no insulting, offensive or vulgar comments or displays are to be presented. Floats or costumes that give offence will not be accepted.
2. The Parade is a festive occasion to celebrate the lifestyle of Port Adelaide Enfield and is not be used to promote any political philosophies.
3. No potentially dangerous activities to be undertaken on any moving vehicle.
4. Giveaways are welcome; however the practice of throwing give-aways from **moving** vehicles will not be permitted.
5. Participants or helpers must walk adjacent to onlookers and their vehicle; give-aways must be handed into the crowd.
6. Standing persons on vehicles will be permitted with sufficient protection erected around the sides or in special circumstances with prior approval.
7. Unsupervised children on utilities, trailers etc. with open sides is strictly prohibited.
8. Ensure proper care and supervision of children at all times.
9. Moving vehicles with adults standing on them will be subject to inspection. As a useful guideline, normal trailer sides are of adequate protection.
10. Vehicles must only stop in an emergency or as directed by Marshals.
11. No float is to have a Father Christmas – only one Father Christmas will appear in the Parade, organised by the City of Port Adelaide Enfield.
12. Failure to comply with procedures and guidelines may result in being expelled from the Parade by authorised Parade Marshals.
13. The City of Port Adelaide Enfield reserves the right not to accept any presentations that could be damaging to the spirit of the Parade.

**In the case of inclement weather, please do not assume that the event will be cancelled.**

Council will make a decision regarding cancellation in such circumstances, so please attend unless notified otherwise by Council.
